If you are looking for a venue on the beach check out the hotels. One popular and recently opened venue is the [Sand Pearl](#). They have professional event planners on staff and will work with you on all the details of the event, from the food to the decor. They are a pricier option, but one that is elegant and sophisticated. It will also give you one vendor to work with as opposed to several.

If you would like a more do it yourself option the [Clearwater Community Sailing Center](#) is available for rentals. They are a small venue and can easily accommodate up to 75 people. Using this option you will need to be your own event planner and coordinate all of your needed vendors, from the caterer to the musicians. The center sits on the intracoastal just across from [Sand Key Park](#).

On the other side of the bay there is the [A La Cart Event Pavillion](#). They are a full service event venue. They only focus on events and have a professional staff available to help you realize your event as you dream it to be.
